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## Hopedale Public Schools

### Proof of Residency Requirements

All families registering a new student with the Hopedale Public Schools must bring the following required documents to the administrative office at the school their children will be attending as part of the registration process.

**All of these:**

- Child's original birth certificate, I-94 form, or passport
- Child's up-to-date immunization record (see below)
- Parent/Guardian's photo identification
- A deed or mortgage payment dated within the past 60 days
- or
- a property tax bill dated within the last year
- or
- a current lease or section 8 agreement

Residency fraud is a violation of Massachusetts state law and is subject to per diem fines for every day that a student attends a school outside the district in which he/she legally resides.

**Two of these:**

- A utility bill (not water or cell phone) dated within the past 60 days
- A W2 form dated within the year, or a payroll stub dated within the past 60 days
- A bank or credit card statement dated within the past 60 days
- A letter from an approved government agency\* dated within the past 60 days

**Approved Government Agencies:** Dept. of Transitional Assistance (DTA), Dept. of Revenue (DOR), Children and Family Services (DCF), Dept. of Youth Services (DYS), Social Security, any communications on Commonwealth of Massachusetts letterhead
